SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION - 2021

NOTE: Eligible students must be legally blind, reside in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, or Will Counties, and be enrolled/accepted in an accredited degree program during the fall of 2021.

In addition to your completed application, you must submit the following:

1. Two letters of recommendation from past instructors or other academic professionals who can comment on your scholastic or other achievements. Repeat applicants need only submit one letter of recommendation.
2. An autobiographical essay, as described on the last page of the application. Past recipients must submit a summary of precisely how past scholarship money was spent.
3. Official transcripts of grades from most recent school or schools. Proof of your acceptance in an accredited educational institution is required.
4. A recent eye report (no older than 2 years), certifying legal blindness.
5. A valid state identification.

Send all materials together to Blind Service Association at the above address.

The deadline for submission of completed applications is April 1, 2021.

- Interviews with all qualified applicants are required and will be scheduled for May 2021.
- Scholarship applicants will be informed of whether they have been awarded or not awarded a scholarship in the weeks following the completed interviews.
- Announcement of scholarship awards will be made at Blind Service Association's Annual Meeting in June. Awardees are expected to attend and scholarship awards will be presented at this time. Winners must sign for their scholarship in person.
- BSA awards individual scholarships up to \$3,000.
- All decisions of the BSA scholarship committee are final.
